e-Taster provides short, free on-line courses i.e., 'tasters', for multilingual, international delivery. Courses are based on an advanced e-learning methodology. The international delivery of the courses is intended in multilingual format. The objective is to make the courses available free of charge to the general public in several countries.

The consortium of the eTaster project is based on the previous, wide range collaboration of partners representing the two networks, the newly established „e-Collegium” Foundation and the prestigious EADTU (European Association of Distance Teaching Universities). The project should be considered as a direct follow up program for the MISSION Minerva project (90389 CP-1-2001-1-MINERVA-HU), aiming at strengthening the links between the CEE PHARE ODL Centres – established by the support of the former PHARE Multi-country Programme for Distance Education – and improving the effectiveness and long-term stability of collaboration between EuroStudy Centres EADTU and PHARE ODL Centres.
